If the answer is **YES**, the AIDS Committee of North Bay & Area would like you to consider joining its Board of Directors.

The AIDS Committee of North Bay & Area is a volunteer-driven, charitable, non-profit, community-based organization. Our mission is to *assist and support all persons infected or affected by HIV/AIDS and/or Hepatitis C and to limit the spread of the virus through education and outreach strategies, and treatment.*

We are recruiting four to five new Board members who can support the development of the organization and lead the implementation of our next strategic plan currently being developed. Board members commit to attend 10 meetings in a year and are expected to participate in at least one board committee. These committees are Finance, Governance, Recruitment, and Advocacy, along with the Executive Committee. The monthly commitment for a board member can vary, but on an average is between 4-6 hours per month. Board members are asked to commit to a three-year term.

ACNBA is committed to equity at all levels of the organization and has, as one of its core commitments, the greater and meaningful engagement of people living with HIV and AIDS and HCV. Our board includes two dedicated seats for people living with HIV and those with lived or living Hep C experience. ACNBA encourages members of our priority populations – people living with HIV/AIDS and/or Hep C, cis and trans gay/bi/queer men, cis and trans women, cis and trans young people, members of diverse ethno-racial communities and members of Indigenous communities (including 2-Spirit people) - to apply and self-identify. Board members will be required to complete Safer Spaces training to take up the role.
